





# Windows 10 Release Next Month Free for existing Windows 7, 8 and 8.1 Users!

With Windows 8 and today Windows 8.1, Microsoft tried – not entirely successfully – to deliver an operating system (OS) that could handle the needs of not only number-crunching workstations and high-end gaming rigs, but touch-controlled systems from all-in-one PCs for the family and thin-and-light notebooks down to slender tablets.

Skipping the Windows 9 name completely, Microsoft now plans to release it's all new operating system in the last quarter of July and the big draw card that has many users

interested is the fact that it will be entirely free for users who already run Windows 7, Windows 8 or Windows 8.1 if they claim their copy within the first year of it's release and support it with updates throughout the life of the Windows device's lifetime.

Prices for standalone copies of the operating system or those who upgrade after the first 12-months will begin at around \$120.

### Data Protection


#### A Word Of Warning

The last few months I have seen many cases where critical data, both personal and that used to operate local businesses has been lost as a result of poor or non-existent backup routines. As a general rule you should consider it only a matter of when and not if you are going to lose a file if you only have a single copy of it.

Rough numbers put the average lifespan of a hard disk drive, internal drives (the ones inside your PC or laptop) or external drives (those you plug in via USB) is 6 years although 1 in 5 drives will fail in the first 2 years of operation. Hard disk failure, though the most common cause of data-loss is not the only cause. Others being virus infections, malicious users or hackers and natural disasters; fires and flooding etc.

If you have critical data stored on any of your devices, be sure to make at least another copy of it and store it on a separate device, either another computer, another hard disk drive or USB flash drive.


